## **Casting Call**

Below are suggestions for assigning your students to specific roles.

Social Rating	This is an indication of the social demands on the role. Extroverted students will enjoy the demands of the higher rated roles.						
Academic Rating	Rating This is an indication of the academic demands of a role. Your most academically advanced students will enjoy the challenges of the higher rated roles.						
Prestige Rating	This is an indication of the prestige or "importance" of the role within the fiction of the simulation.						

#### Other Casting Notes

- Assign one of your most conscientious students to lead each of the network teams (Chief White House Correspondent).

- Assign your most social/confident student to the role of Deputy Press Secretary.

- The roles with the highest social ratings require students to be self-starters who will interject themselves into the decision making process.

- The roles with the highest prestige rating do not necessarily require your best or most social students. They are always included in discussions by virtue of their "importance."

- You may want to put friends who want to work together on the same Network team.

- Any roles above 37 will be assigned to one of the Press teams.

### **Network Team Assignments**

Educators should complete the network assignments first. Groups with 20 - 25 participants should complete the team roles for CNN and NBC. Groups with 26 - 33 participants should complete the team roles for CNN, NBC, and CBS. Groups with 34 or more participants should complete all network roles. <u>The network teams will not function unless they are full</u>, <u>EACH NETWORK TEAM MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF FOUR TEAM MEMBERS</u>.</u> If there are more than 37 students, students who are not assigned a unique role will serve as network reporters.
