ROLE

The Secretary of State is a Cabinet level member of the executive branch. You run the Department of State which is responsible for the international relations of the United States.

BACKGROUND

Your brief time as a Secretary of State has proven difficult. You are an expert at military matters and foreign policy as well as a veteran of White House politics. Your problem is that a number of self-important advisors have placed themselves between you and the President, restricting or even eliminating your access to the President.

This crisis is an opportunity to prove your worth as a leader and bring order to chaos.

RELATIONSHIPS

The Secretary of Defense is new to the job and inexperienced and could use your guidance.

The National Security Advisor is too focused on everyone singing Kumbaya and holding hands. This is a time for decisiveness not leadership by committee.

The White House Chief of Staff and the Special Assistant to the President relish their role as gatekeepers. The power they have is access to the President. In this crisis, they are meaningless. However, open confrontation with them would be self- defeating.

The Deputy Secretary of State is a brilliant young mind. Use your deputy to gather information for you as well as to communicate unofficially with the Press so the nation appreciates the leadership you are providing.

The NBC Chief White House Correspondent may be known as "the Dean of the White House Press Corps", but is better known, rightly, as "the Enemy". Reporters like that are the reason for prepared statement. Don't go off script with that reporter around.

The ABC Medical Correspondent has a good heart. This doctor is less of a reporter and more of an advocate for health issues around the world. You can trust this person if you need to deal with someone in the media.

Role Explanation – Secretary of State

SECRETARY OF STATE

The Secretary of State is a senior official of the federal government of the United States, heading the U.S. Department of state, the State Department is principally concerned with foreign affairs.

The Secretary appointed by the President with the advice and consent of the Senate, is a member of the President's Cabinet, the National Security Council, and is the highestranking appointed executive branch official both in the presidential line of succession and the order of precedence.

The Secretary of State along with the Secretary of the Treasury, the Secretary of Defense, and the Attorney General are generally regarded as the four most important cabinet members because of the importance of their respective departments.

The specific duties of the Secretary of State include:



- i. Organizes and supervises the entire United States Department of State and the United States Foreign Service.
- ii. Advises the President on matters relating to U.S. foreign policy, including the appointment of diplomatic representatives to other nations, and on the acceptance or dismissal of representatives from other nations.
- iii. Participates in high-level negotiations with other countries, either bilaterally or as part of an international conference or organization, or appoints representatives to do so. This includes the negotiation of international treaties and other agreements.
- iv. Communicates issues relating the United States foreign policy to Congress and to U.S. citizens.

As the highest ranking member of the cabinet, the Secretary of State is the third highest-ranking official of the executive branch of the Federal Government of the United States, after the President and Vice President and is fourth in line to succeed the presidency, coming after the Vice President, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President pro tempore of the Senate.

As the head of the United States Foreign Service, the Secretary of State is responsible for management of the diplomatic service of the United States. The Foreign Service employs about 12,000 people domestically and internationally, and supports 265 United States diplomatic missions around the world, including ambassadors to various nations.

Cabinet Member – This position is a member of the Cabinet and is a Senate-confirmed head of a department. A Cabinet member qualifies as a "principal officer of (an) Executive Department" for purposes of Section 4 of the 25th Amendment.

Character Sheet – Secretary of Defense

ROLE

The Secretary of Defense is a cabinet level member of the executive branch. You exercise command and control, subject only to the orders of the President, over all Department of Defense forces.

BACKGROUND

You are veteran of Vietnam but have served most of your career as a politician in the President's home state. Your loyalty to the President is absolute.

GOALS

- i. Do everything necessary to protect the country against military threats during this time of crisis.
- ii. Fill the leadership void in any issue that concerns the nation's defense. You answer only to the President.
- iii. Determine if there is a foreign link to the assassination attempt and respond accordingly.

The President knows your worth. That's why you got the job. Others in the White House are less sure and are not shy with their doubts. You can best serve the President by "minding the store" until the President is capable of fulfilling that role.

You know that there is no situation more serious than a "decapitation" strike against the government of the United States. You doubt that it is mere coincidence that the President is attacked at a time when the Vice President is unable to assume command. You suspect that some foreign government or agent is planning something big while America nurses its wounds.



RELATIONSHIPS

The Secretary of State is all too eager to do your job for you. That cannot be allowed to happen. Still, you know that all that experience has value.

The National Security Advisor can be helpful in herding the cats and keeping the discussions focused.

The White House Chief of Staff is a longtime friend and colleague. You know that none of the President's advisors care for the Secretary of State's bluster. Best to keep their ire focused on someone else rather than you.

Role Explanation – Secretary of Defense

UNITED STATES SECRETARY OF DEFENSE

The Secretary of Defense (SecDef) is the leader and chief executive officer of the Department of Defense, an Executive Department of the Government of the United States of America. The Secretary of Defense's power over the United States military is second only to that of the President. The Secretary of Defense is appointed by the President with the advice and consent of the Senate, and is by custom a member of the Cabinet and by law a member of the National Security Council.

Secretary of Defense is a statutory office, and the general provision in 10 U.S.C. 113 provides that the Secretary of Defense has "authority, direction and control over the Department of Defense," and is further designated by the same statute as "the principal assistant to the President in all matters relating to the Department of Defense. Ensuring civilian control of the military, an individual may not be appointed as Secretary of Defense within seven years after relief from as a commissioned officer of a regular (i.e., non-reserve) component of an armed force."

The Secretary of Defense is in the chain of command and exercises command and control, subject only to the orders of the President, over all Department of Defense forces (the Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marine Corps) for both operational and administrative purposes.

Character Sheet – Deputy Press Secretary

ROLE

The Deputy Press Secretary must act as spokesperson for the United States government administration, especially with regard to the President, senior executives, and policies when the Press Secretary is not available.

BACKGROUND

You are new to public relations and have much to learn. Fortunately the Press Secretary is a real pro so you have plenty of time to learn on the job.

GOALS

- i. Encourage active and accurate communication between the Situation Room and the press. This is how the government communicates with people of the United States.
- ii. Organize an initial press conference between the Situation Room and the Press.
- iii. Protect the image of the President at this moment of greatest vulnerability.

Your background is in party politics. You are highly capable of articulating the party line but are inexperienced in the subtle dance which is the White House's relationship with the national press. Your boss, the Press Secretary, handles all the tough subjects when the press is likely to smell blood.

You think of yourself as a "people person". People generally like you and you like them. The Press has a job to do and your job is often to help them do their jobs. You know that many people within the Situation Room view the press as the enemy and favor an information blackout at all times. This is a mistake. The key to this crisis is winning the press over and convincing everyone that we are all on the same team.

RELATIONSHIPS

The Secretary of State treats you with open contempt. You are surprised the Secretary even knows your name. You wouldn't mind being an anonymous source on an unflattering story about the Secretary. You know many people in the press who are eager to write that story.

The White House chief of staff is a legend in party politics. You wouldn't have this job if the Chief of Staff didn't like you. Not someone to make an enemy of.

The Special Assistant to the President is another friend of the party. Anyone who wants access to the President needs to keep the Special Assistant happy.

The Assistant Attorney General from the Office of Legal Counsel is a brilliant legal mind who could be of great value in determining what the law demands in situations like this one.

The Assistant Director-in-Charge of the FBI in Washington D.C. is going to be a valuable source of information about the assassination attempt. Keep the lines of communication open.

The NBC Chief White House Correspondent is your personal enemy. This reporter takes delight in making you look foolish.

The NBC Digital Correspondent has been a willing ally in the past. You have provided behind-the-scenes information, off the record of course, in exchange for stories that have reflected well upon the President.

Role Explanation – Deputy Press Secretary

DEPUTY PRESS SECRETARY

[This description is for the White House Press Secretary a role as the Deputy you must now fill.]

The White House Press Secretary is a senior White House official whose primary responsibility is to act as spokesman for the United States government administration, especially with regard to the President, senior executives, and policies.

The Press Secretary is responsible for collecting information about actions and events within the President's administration and issues the administration's reactions to developments around the world. The Press Secretary interacts with the media, and

deals with the White House press corps on a daily basis, generally in a daily press briefing.

The Press Secretary serves by the appointment of and at the pleasure of the President; the office does not require the advice and consent of the U.S. Senate, though because of the frequent briefings given to the media, who in turn inform the public, the position is still a very prominent non-Cabinet post.

You should coordinate your efforts with the White House Communications Director and the White House Political Director.

- The Deputy Press Secretary should be responsible for running both press conferences.
- The White House Communications Director should be the main link between the Deputy Press Secretary and the decisions made in the Situation Room. This person keeps the Deputy Press Secretary informed as events and decisions enfold.
- The White House Political Director should be actively engaging with members of the press and aiding them in confirming their stories with the administration.







Character Sheet – White House Counsel

ROLE

The White House Counsel is the presidential contact for the Department of Justice, responsible for advising on all legal aspects of policy questions, legal issues arising connection with the President's decision to sign or veto legislation, ethical questions, financial disclosures, and conflicts of interest.

BACKGROUND

You are the President's lawyer- the office, not the man. You serve the American people. Perhaps you can bring a reasoned perspective to a room full of career politicians. Make sure the good of the American people is served.

GOALS

- i. Manage the decision to (or not) invoke the 25th Amendment. It is your job to make sure a decision is reached.
- ii. Resolve the Constitutional Crisis. Who is in "control"?
- iii. Make sure the rule of law is observed.

Secretary of Transportation

Your job is to provide clarity where none exists. The cabinet is filled with strong and eager leaders but you must make sure that they do not exceed their authority this time of crisis. Fortunately you have prepared for a situation like this. You have documents in your possession that can allow the Vice President to assume the presidency but it's been some time since you familiarized yourself with the specifics. Now would be the time to get more familiar with the 25th Amendment and the Laws of Succession. Everyone will be looking to you for some clarity.

You should make sure that the Cabinet is following the law in every action they take. Many will be tempted to take action without proper presidential authority. The White House staff is a real danger here to the proper operation of the government. They will protect the political career of the President over all things. Fortunately they do not have a legally recognized role in the process.

RELATIONSHIPS

The Attorney General is the head of the Department of Justice and should lead any discussions of presidential succession. You suspect that the Attorney General will be busy determining the law enforcement response to the attack. Fill that void.

The White House Chief of Staff is your boss and someone you admire greatly. This is complicated. Doing the right thing for the American people might get you fired.

The Assistant Attorney General in the Office of Legal Counsel is a brilliant legal mind and a potential ally in resolving this crisis. Together, the two of you should be able to determine what the law demands in this situation.

The CNN Chief White House Correspondent is a fellow lawyer and a good one. They might be a good person to get a legal second opinion from... off the record of course.

Role Explanation – White House Counsel

WHITE HOUSE COUNSEL

The White House Counsel is a staff appointee of the President of the United States whose role is to advise the President on all legal issues concerning the President and the President's Administration.

The Office of Counsel to the President is responsible for advising on all legal aspects of policy questions, legal issues arising in connection with the President's decision to sign or veto legislation, ethical questions, financial disclosures, and conflicts of interest during employment and post-employment.

The Counsel's Office also helps define the line between official and political activities, oversees executive appointments and judicial selection, handles presidential pardons, reviews legislation and presidential statements, and handles lawsuits against the

President in his role as President, as well as serving as the White House contact for the Department of Justice.

Although the White House Counsel offers legal advice to the President, the Counsel does so in the President's official capacity, and does not serve as the President's personal attorney. Therefore, controversy has emerged over the scope of the attorney-client privilege between the Counsel and the President. It is clear, however, that the privilege does not apply in personal matters, such as impeachment proceedings; thus, in such situations the President relies on a personal attorney for confidential legal advice.





Character Sheet - Secretary of the Treasury

ROLE

The Secretary of the Treasury is a cabinet level member of the executive branch and is the Chief Financial Officer of the government. You head the Department of the Treasury and oversee the International Monetary Fund.

BACKGROUND

You are a high-profile investment banker who was named Secretary of the Treasury due, in part, to your good relations with Russian oligarchs going back to your numerous visits over the decades. Despite your extreme personal wealth, your highest priority is the growing income inequality in the United States.

GOALS

- i. Take action to protect the economic health of the United States during this time of crisis.
- ii. Do what is best for the people of the United States in deciding whether to invoke the 25th Amendment.
- iii. Demonstrate your leadership abilities in this time of national need.

The Secretary oversees the activities of the Department in carrying out its major law enforcement responsibilities; in serving as the financial agent for the United States Government; and in manufacturing coins and currency.

Cabinet Member – This position is a member of the Cabinet and is a Senate-confirmed head of a department. A Cabinet member qualifies as a "principal officer of (an) Executive Department" for purposes of Section 4 of the 25th Amendment.

Character Sheet - National Security Advisor

ROLE

The Assistant to the President for National Security Affairs (National Security Advisor) advises the President on all issues of National Security. You are part of the Office of the Executive and therefore answer to the President and his Chief of Staff.

BACKGROUND

You are a career diplomat, having served the National Security Council and State Department in numerous capacities. You have a reputation for solving foreign crises without having to resort to military force.

GOALS

- i. Your job is to coordinate interagency decision making and actions. This role becomes critical without the President and Vice President here.
- ii. Keep the Secretaries of State and Defense from taking us into war.
- iii. Make sure Situation Room discussions stay on track while remaining civil.

You are a consensus builder; you like helping people figure out solutions everyone can agree on... which is exactly what is needed right now. This room is filled with leaders ready to "take charge" and tell everyone else what to do. The only way this doesn't devolve into screaming matches and turf battles is for you to manage the process.

As the National Security Advisor, you don't have the power to do anything on your own which means you have the freedom to solicit everyone's input and advice. Cooler heads must prevail today.

Technically, the Situation Room falls under your authority. If things get loud feel free to expel non-essential personnel.

RELATIONSHIPS

The Secretary of State is a powerful personality who only respects strength. The Secretary of State needs your counsel even if they don't realize it. The Deputy Secretary of State is quite arrogant and covets your job. Watch out for that one.

The Secretary of Defense lacks confidence. You can provide that.

The Secretary of the Treasury is an egotist of the highest order. Wealth does not always command respect. Keep this one from taking over the discussions.

The NBC Chief White House Correspondent is known as "the Dean of the White House Press Corps." Most White House staff regard "the Dean" as "the Enemy". You've always found "the Dean" to be great at doing a tough job.

Role Explanation – National Security Advisor

NATIONAL SECURITY ADVISOR

The Assistant to the President for National Security Affairs, commonly referred to as the National Security Advisor or at times informally termed the NSC advisor, is a senior aide in the Executive Office of the President, based at the West Wing of the White House, who serves as the chief in-house advisor to the President of the United States on national security issues.

The National Security Advisor is appointed by the President without confirmation by the Senate. The National Security Advisor serves as an honest broker of policy options for the President in the field of national security, rather than as an advocate for their own policy agenda.

However, the National Security Advisor is a staff position in the Executive Office of the President and does not have line or budget authority over either the Department of State or the Department of Defense, unlike the Secretary of State and the Secretary of Defense, who are Senate-confirmed officials with statutory authority over their departments; but the National Security Advisor is able to offer daily advice (due to the proximity) to the President independently of the vested interests of the large bureaucracies and clientele of those departments.

In times of crisis, the National Security Advisor is likely to operate from the White House Situation Room, updating the President on the latest events in a crisis situation.

Character Sheet – Attorney General

ROLE

The Attorney General is a cabinet level member of the executive branch and is the nation's chief law enforcement officer, heading the Department of Justice. You oversee many departments including the FBI and the DEA.

BACKGROUND

You were a former Federal Prosecutor and then Governor of the State of Ohio. With the President unavailable, you see it as your role to restore order to the nation. The rule of law will be respected and enforced on your watch.

GOALS

- i. Determine who is behind the assassination attempt and why. Take all necessary actions to bring any and all conspirators to justice.
- ii. Share information learned from the FBI with other members of the Executive Branch.
- iii. Ensure that the law is followed in determining who is in charge and what steps, if any, should be taken to relieve the President of his duty.

If ever a situation demanded law and order, this is it. With the President in the hospital and the Vice President unavailable, there will be a temptation for the members of the Cabinet to exceed their legal authority. You should prevent that.

That said, your job needs to be completely focused on getting to the bottom of the attack on the President. Ensure that the FBI is doing everything in their power to investigate this crime. Part of your job is to get the best information to the other members of the Situation Room so that they can make informed decisions.

As head of the Department of Justice, you should be actively involved in any question of presidential succession. Do what is best for the American people, not necessarily what is best for this administration.

RELATIONSHIPS

The Washington D.C. Assistant Director-in-Charge of the FBI is managing the investigation. Make sure the Assistant Director doesn't disappear down a rabbit hole and forget to keep you informed of the investigation's progress.

The Secretary of Homeland Security is a political appointee pretending to be a lawman. Make sure the Secretary is sharing any information the Secret Service learns with the FBI.

The Assistant Attorney General in the Office of Legal Counsel is a smart young lawyer but is not always a team player and talks too much... to everyone. You might have to pull rank to keep this one in line.

The NBC Political Analyst is a lawyer who has made a living by bring legal challenges against various law enforcement practices. You don't agree with this person often but you respect their motivations. Why did a successful lawyer start working as a network "talking head"?

WHITE HOUSE CHIEF OF STAFF

The White House Chief of Staff is the highest-ranking employee of the White House.

The position is a modern successor to the earlier role of the President's private secretary. The role was formalized as the Assistant to the President in 1946 and acquired its current name in 1961.

The Chief of Staff is appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the President; it does not require Senate confirmation.

The duties of the White House Chief of Staff vary greatly from one administration to another, and in fact, there is no legal requirement that the president even fill the position. However, since at least 1979, all presidents have found the need for a Chief of Staff, who typically oversees the actions of the White House staff and manages the President's schedule.

The roles of the Chief of Staff are both managerial and advisory and can include the following:

- Select key White House staff and supervise them
- Structure the White House staff system
- Control the flow of people into the Oval Office
- Manage the flow of information
- Protect the interests of the president
- Negotiate with Congress, other members of the executive branch, and extragovernmental political groups to implement the President's agenda
- Advise the president on various issues

The Special Assistant to the President is someone you work with every day in preparing the President's schedule. Any information concerning the health of the President will come through the Special Assistant.

SECRET SERVICE AGENT-IN-CHARGE

RELATIONSHIPS

The White House Chief of Staff is a classic "frenemy". You are both supposed to be equal in the President's eyes, but that doesn't stop the constant jockeying for favor. Ultimately event the Chief of Staff needs you if they want unfettered access to the President. Sometimes even the Chief of Staff needs to be subtly reminded of that. The Chief of Staff headed the presidential campaign for the Vice President before she lost the primary and became part of the ticket. You're sure the Chief of Staff is still very personally loyal to the Vice President.

The White House Physician is a personal friend of the President's, though it is more accurate to call them "drinking buddies".

The Director of National Intelligence is very loyal to the President and the administration.

The Secretary of Commerce is actually from the other political party, but knows to keep you happy. Make sure the Secretary votes the way you want on the 25th Amendment.

The ABC Political Analyst is a personal friend. You share a love of gourmet cuisine. In the past you've been able to back-channel information to ABC off the record that reflected well on the President. Your fiend could help control the story if someone inside the White House endangers the President's legacy.

You've shared information with the CBS Chief White House Correspondent in the past as well.

The NBC Chief White House Correspondent may be known as "the Dean of the White House Press Corps", but is better known, rightly, as "the Enemy". Reporters like that are the reason for prepared statements. Don't go off script with that reporter around.

SPECIAL ASSISTANT TO THE PRESIDENT



The Physician to the President (also known colloquially as the White House doctor) is the formal and official title of the physician who is director of the White House Medical Unit, a unit of the White House Military Office responsible for the medical needs of the President of the United States, Vice President, White House staff, and visitors.

The White House physician has an office inside the White House. The location of their medical unit plays an important role in keeping the President of the United States



healthy. They also oversee a staff which is typically composed of five military physicians, five nurses, five physician assistants, three medics, three administrators and one IT Manager. The White House Physician is metaphorically the "shadow of the President" because they are always close at hand whether the President is at the White House, overseas, on the campaign trail, or aboard presidential plane Air Force One. The Physician to the President protects the president's health and may also perform emergency surgery.

The White House doctor is also responsible for providing comprehensive medical care to the members of the President's immediate family, the Vice President, and the Vice President's family. They may also provide medical care and attention to the more than 1.5 million visitors who tour the White House each year, as well as to international dignitaries and other guests of the President.

The medical office of the White House doctor is a "mini urgent-care center" containing a physician's office, private examination rooms, basic medications and medical supplies, and a crash cart for emergency resuscitation.

RELATIONSHIPS

Your expertise in the law has made you a favorite of the White House Counsel. The questions of who is in charge and what should be done concerning the President are, at their core, legal questions. The White House Counsel will no doubt be at the center of that determination. Use your relationship to get access to the story of a lifetime.

The CNN Political Analyst is what you call a "real journalist". This is a reporter who seems to be always prepared and always aware of the politics in play, but maybe not the best on camera... Though the political analyst answers to you, you know that they actually know the White House better than anyone.

The White House Political Director is a former journalist and long-time political advisor with much more experience and candor than the Deputy Press Secretary. If you can't get straight answers out of the rookie press secretary, the White House Political Director might be a reliable source...off the record...and if it's flattering to the administration.

This crisis is an opportunity to lead your team and establish NBC as the leader in old-school hard-hitting journalism.

RELATIONSHIPS

The National Security Advisor is a career negotiator and diplomat, not a partisan party hack. You share a common language of respect, dignity, and trust. The National Security Advisor is the kind of person who might be willing to do the right thing for the country even if it isn't the right thing for the President. You could be a sympathetic ear if partisan loyalty is the order of the day.

The Deputy Press Secretary is unequipped for this job. You don't like making someone look bad but the Deputy's incompetence is on constant display. If the White House sends this buffoon to the podium, you know they are attempting to give the press the runaround.

The Director of National Intelligence is dangerous. This vampire would probably lock the Press Corps out of the White House if it were an option. You believe this person has intentionally fed misleading information to your news organization in the past in an attempt to embarrass NBC and discredit the press in general.

The NBC Medical Correspondent is a network darling, the famous "Doc Science". The good doctor is an entertainer not a journalist. The network will probably push to put Doc Science in front of the camera, but you need to make sure your team is doing its job as journalists, reporting the facts.

The White House Political Director is a former journalist and long-time political advisor with much more experience and candor than the Deputy Press Secretary. If you can't get straight answers out of the rookie press secretary, the White House Political Director might be a reliable source....off the record...and if it's flattering to the administration.

RELATIONSHIPS

You have had many dealings with the Attorney General (AG), who heads the Department of Justice. You know the AG has to project a strong "law and order" attitude, but you know the ex-governor to be a reasonable person.

What would be a real coup is if your use of technology and social media actually helped you get to the bottom of this crisis. Imagine you, the lowly digital correspondent scooping all these so-called journalistic heavyweights.

As far as politics go, you just care about the tech. You believe in net neutrality and freedom of information in any form. You don't trust secrets and believe that it is almost

always the right thing to let the public know about something rather than letting the government decide.

- ii. Assist the Attorney General in all things. You will receive dozens of communications during the crisis which you will need to pass on to the very busy Attorney General.
- iii. Aid the members of the Press in their understanding of the law. You are happy to be a source on any question of law.

Let's face it: you're a legal hotshot and your future is on the Supreme Court, that is, if you can avoid the kinds of complications that will make a future confirmation hearing difficult.

Your job is to study the proper law and provide guidance about what should be done legally about the presidency. You should start with reacquainting yourself with the 25th Amendment and the Acts of Succession so that you can provide advice to others, even the press. Frankly, it's crises like these that can catapult a person into the national spotlight.

You know from studying the 25th Amendment previously that the law allows tremendous discretion to the Vice President and Cabinet in deciding whether to invoke the 25th Amendment. Who is to say how long the President can be incapacitated before it's appropriate to consider passing the helm to the Vice President? These are political judgment calls, not legal questions.

The 25th Amendment provides for the temporary transfer of presidential power to the Vice President but you know that most of the President's advisors will be hostile to the very idea. You may need to reassure them that the 25th was written so that the President can reassume power quickly and easily. The President's "men" will likely overstate the political damage to the administration as a justification not to invoke the 25th amendment.

RELATIONSHIPS

The White House Counsel is a friend and mentor, though not the greatest lawyer. You should be able to provide some guidance so your friend doesn't make too big of a hash of things.

The Special Assistant to the President scares you. This is the kind of person who is willing to push others around to achieve their political goals. Avoid picking a fight with this one.

You have had a number of dealings with the Presidential Physician who always seems to be hovering around the President. You're not sure this "pal" of the President would always be honest about the President's true condition. That said, who better that the President's doctor to make a determination if the President is fit to serve?

DEPUTY ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL, OFFICE OF LEGAL COUNSEL

A Deputy Assistant Attorney General heads the Office of Legal Counsel.

The Office of Legal Counsel (OLC) is an office in the United States Department of Justice that assists the Attorney General in his function as legal adviser to the President and all executive branch agencies.

The Office of Legal Counsel (OLC) assists the Attorney General of the United States in their function as legal adviser to the President and all the executive branch agencies, hence the appellation "the president's law firm." The OLC drafts legal opinions of the Attorney General and also provides its own written opinions and oral advice in response to requests from the Counsel to the President, the various agencies of the executive branch, and offices within the Department of Justice. Such requests typically deal with legal issues of particular complexity and importance or about which two or more agencies are in disagreement. The Office also is responsible for providing legal advice to the executive branch on all constitutional questions and reviewing pending legislation for constitutionality. The decisions of the Office are binding on all executive agencies.

All executive orders and proclamations proposed to be issued by the President are reviewed by the OLC for form and legality, as are various other matters that require the President's formal approval.

In addition to serving as, in effect, outside counsel for the other agencies of the executive branch, the OLC also functions as general counsel for the Department of Justice itself. It reviews all proposed orders of the Attorney General and all regulations requiring the Attorney General's approval.

You know that the best way to do this is competent preparation. During a crisis, your main goal is to maintain order and avoid having fear and panic rule the nation.



You are an almost religious believer that the right thing to do and the legal thing to do are usually the same thing. You should openly advocate for the administration responses that adhere rigorously to the law. You know from experience that during

crises, the temptation to bend or break the law is at its strongest. That said, your rights don't mean much if you are dead. Balancing the need to protect the nation against terrorism with the desire to adhere to all the laws all the time is difficult to say the least.

You have an excellent relationship with the Vice President and know that the nation would be in safe, capable hands if the Vice President has to assume the helm of the nation.

RELATIONSHIPS

The Attorney General and White House Counsel are both excellent lawyers, can be too deliberative. In a crisis, the government must fight its own inertia.

The Secret Service Agent-in-Charge is not someone you know, but this agent is now your main source of information on the attack. Demand updates on the investigation and on the situation at the hospital.

You maintain positive relationships with the Political Analysts at both NBC and CBS. You do not believe in ever leaking to the press but you try to be as forthcoming as possible. Being evasive with the press rarely helps.

SECRETARY OF HOMELAND SECURITY

RELATIONSHIPS

DIRECTOR OF NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE

The position of Director of National Intelligence was created in 2004 to oversee the nation's many intelligence gathering agencies.

Intelligence is the gathering and assessment of strategic, tactical, and policy information.

The Director of National Intelligence serves as the principal advisor to the President, National Security Council, and Homeland Security Council about intelligence matters related to national security as well as serving as the head of the seventeen-member United States Intelligence Community.

The United States Intelligence Community consists of:

- The Central Intelligence Agency (CIA)

The Central Intelligence Agency is the civilian foreign intelligence service of the U.S. government. It is tasked with gathering, processing, and analyzing national security information from around the world, primarily through the use of human intelligence (HUMINT). Unlike the FBI, which is a domestic security service, the CIA has no law



enforcement function. The CIA is the only agency authorized by law to carry out and oversee covert action on behalf of the President. The CIA has increasingly expanded its role to include covert paramilitary operations.

The National Security Agency (NSA) is an intelligence organization of the United States government, responsible for global monitoring, collection, and processing of information and data for foreign intelligence and counterintelligence purposes - a discipline known as signals intelligence (SIGINT). NSA is concurrently charged with protection of U.S. government communications and information systems against penetration and network warfare.

You need to make sure that all the major decisions are made here in the hospital with the real leadership. The White House Chief of Staff and the Special Assistant to the President are the true power behind the throne and you cross them at your peril. Do whatever you can to make the hospital the center of the decision making process.

You have a good working relationship with the CBS Medical Reporter and the ABC Digital Reporter. If you help them cover this crisis, they should be willing to provide positive press on your "leadership behind the scenes."

You have a strong background as a party loyalist, having formerly run the party's leadership council as well as an educational nonprofit organization. You also hold the title of Assistant to the President.

You must represent the Vice President in all matters within the Situation Room. You realize that the Vice President can NEVER openly advocate that she assume the presidency via invoking the 25th Amendment. To do so would seem presumptive and disloyal. However, having the Vice President assume the Presidency may be exactly what the country needs.

There will be dozens in people in the administration who would never want to invoke the 25th Amendment, even if the President were comatose.

YOU must be a vigorous advocate for the Vice President. The President has been shot and is unconscious and in surgery. America needs the Vice President to assume the helm NOW.

You have a good working relationship with the White House Chief of Staff and the Special Assistant to the President but you can expect them to protect the President's power at all costs. That's not what's best for the nation.

You should consider communicating off the record with the press if the White House isn't forthcoming about the President's true condition. And there are the rumors: Once the last election was over, you started hearing rumors that the President had hidden a secret medical condition from the public.

Your internal investigations have confirmed these suspicions. You should be very suspicious of any medical reports coming from the President's Physician or from the Special Assistant to the President. They will not be honest with the American people or, likely, with the President's own Cabinet which must make a decision about the President's ability to carry out the duties of his office. Make sure they tell the Cabinet the truth.

Many in the White House still think you are more loyal to the Vice President than the President, though you don't believe that to be true.

You are an expert at "damage control". You know that the message the press receives needs to be coordinated and consistent. You know that lying to the press is always a mistake, but that doesn't mean the White House always needs to be forthcoming.

You are generally respected by members of the cabinet. You need to be involved in the decisions made in the Situation Room even if it is only so that you can then communicate the administration's intentions to the press and the world.

You maintain personal contact with a number of members of the press. You should attempt to maintain enough contact with them so that they do not publish stories which are either incorrect or harmful to the administration.

RELATIONSHIPS

You like the Deputy Press Secretary but know that the deputy is not ready for the spotlight they are now going to be thrust into. Whatever help you can provide so that the administration seems in control is a high priority of your job.

The White House Political Director is a veteran of many administrations but is far too familiar with members of the press for your tastes. This person often speaks "off the cuff" in a way that doesn't maintain "message discipline". This only makes your job harder. That said, you should encourage the White House Political Director to actively engage with the press during this crisis so that the administration can competently handle the press.

The White House Director of Communications, also known as Assistant to the President for Communications, is part of the senior staff of the President of the United States, and is responsible for developing and promoting the agenda of the President and leading its media campaign. The Deputy Press Secretary should be responsible for running both press conferences.

The White House Communications Director should be the main link between the Deputy Press Secretary and the decisions made in the Situation Room. This person keeps the Deputy Press Secretary informed as events and decisions enfold.

The White House Political Director should be actively engaging with members of the press and aiding them in confirming their stories with the administration.

Without you, the Deputy Press Secretary is in the dark. Keep them informed of any new information you receive.

You personally know the powerful Special Assistant to the President. This person is the real power behind the throne. In the past the Special Assistant has been willing to leak information to you in exchange for stories that have painted the President and the administration in a positive light. You know that the Special Assistant, despite public appearances, does not trust the White House Chief of Staff and would gladly assume that position and become the President's chief advisor.

That cannot be allowed to happen. You a part of a team, along with the Deputy Press Secretary and the White House Communications Director, that should manage public relations in this critical time.

As a former journalist yourself, you have many contacts with members of the press, but rather than exchanging emails, you should likely spend most of your time in the Media Broadcast Center helping the press confirm stories so that the information the public gets is correct and reflects well on the administration.

Each network has your contact information so that they always have access to you, but when possible talk directly with the networks and let the White House Communications Director and Deputy Press Secretary manage communications out of the White House.

Often, the press will have information before the White House does. You should make sure that the Deputy Press Secretary is informed of any new information that the press receives.

Character Sheet – ABC Chief White House Correspondent

ROLE

The Chief White House Correspondent leads the network's team of reporters covering the White House. You should manage and coordinate the actions of your network team.

BACKGROUND

From Harvard to the New York Times to covering the White House, everything comes easily to you. People like you and why shouldn't they?

GOALS

- i. Lead your network's team and organize their efforts. Under your leadership your network should try to be fastest and most accurate network covering this crisis.
- ii. Prepare your team for their live network feed. Determine who can do that job the best. That person is you.
- iii. Enforce journalistic principles on your team. Insist that any story is true and properly sourced.

Your rise at the network has been meteoric. You are next in line to become the main anchor for the network! The problem is that the current anchor isn't eager to retire. You know that a spectacular performance on the national stage could catapult you into the anchor's chair. This crisis provides the opportunity.

Dominate the other networks with your team's speed and accuracy, but more importantly get on camera. Make sure you become the face on camera for your network's live broadcast. A spectacular performance in a press conference could also prove you have the journalistic chops to be the network's top reporter.

RELATIONSHIPS

An ace up your sleeve is your relationship with the White House Chief of Staff. The two of you went to Harvard together and have remained friends over the years, helping each other when possible but never doing anything that would be unprofessional or unethical. This is an opportunity to help your friend, not exploit them.

The White House Political Director is a friend to the press and is often willing to gather information to make sure we get the story right, especially if it reflects well on the administration. This should be your first call to get confirmation on a story.

Role Explanation – ABC Chief White House Correspondent

ABC CHIEF WHITE HOUSE CORRESPONDENT

You are the leader of your network's White House Team. You are ultimately responsible for leading your group and approving any stories before they are published.

ROLE

GOALS

- i. Lead your team on any and all stories concerning politics and any foreign policy complications of this crisis.

- iii. Determine by what means the duties of the Presidency can shift to another person.


