

Teacher/Chaperone Policy 2025

Thank you for your interest in joining us in the Situation Room Experience (SRE). All student groups participating in the Situation Room Experience at the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library and Museum must have <u>one</u> adult chaperone for every <u>ten</u> students. The ratio of 1:10 must be maintained during the entire visit. Teachers are **not** included in the 1:10 chaperone ratio.

Ex.) A class of 30 students must have no less than three (3) Chaperones *in addition* to the Teacher. Thus the visiting group must have at least four (4) adults present with the 30 students at all times.

We recognize that **students with special needs** may have a one-on-one aide as specified in their Individual Education Plan (IEP), 504 Plan, or Special Education Behavior-Support Plan. These dedicated student aides **cannot** be counted in the 1:10 student ratio. Student aides shall not be included in the Teacher/Chaperone 1 to 10 ratio.

Teachers and chaperones must complete and sign the SRE Chaperone Policy document <u>prior</u> to your visit.

The Ronald Reagan Presidential Library and Museum offers both self-guided and guided tours. Visitors who opt for a self-guided tour can enjoy the permanent museum galleries including the Air Force One Pavilion. All students must be accompanied by a chaperone in the Museum. Guided tours provide a knowledgeable docent who will join the chaperone and students during their visit. Please be aware that museum docents do not take the place of teachers or chaperones. Teachers and chaperones are responsible for their students at all times.



As a Teacher/Chaperone I acknowledge that:

- The Situation Room is an **original artifact** removed from the White House in 2006 and installed at the Reagan Library to inspire student civic engagement. I will make sure students respect the space and do not bring in drinks, food, gum, or any damaging substances. Students will be respectful of the space, iPads, museum staff, and their peers.
- Absolutely no backpacks, large bags or purses are allowed inside the facility. Please return
 these items to your vehicle before entering. Bag lunches should be in disposable paper or plastic
 bags that are labeled with the students' names. Place all bag lunches in manageable boxes, bins
 or coolers and store them under the bus. Any lunches must stay on the bus at all times.
 Purchasing lunches on-site from the Reagan Café or the Reagan Pub is also an option for
 Situation Room Experience participants.
- I will stay with students at all times and remain with my students during the Situation Room Experience (SRE) and during the Museum Tour. I acknowledge that I am responsible for my students at all times.
- I will adhere to the ratio of 1:10, one chaperone to ten students, and it will be maintained during the entire visit. I acknowledge that chaperones will stay with students the entirety of the visit.
- Student cell phones must be turned off and put away prior to the start of simulation.
- Chaperones/Teachers, please keep cell phones on silent mode.
- SRE is a **student-led** immersive simulation. To maximize student learning, I may only observe and will not participate unless there are behavioral or safety challenges. SRE-Staff will help students with technical challenges for their iPads. Teachers and chaperones are asked to refrain from assisting students.
- Photography Release Forms are required for each student and must be submitted <u>two weeks</u>
 prior to my visit. Teachers and Chaperones are fully responsible for knowing which students have opted out of photography.
- I am permitted to take photos of my students during the simulation if it is not a distraction.

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- The Ronald Reagan Presidential Library & Museum is monitored by security personnel 24 hours a day, year-round. Security personnel have the ability to evaluate visitor conduct and will take appropriate action to protect collections and holdings.
